

Pondicherry Civil Service, Eligibility, Salary, Training, Roles and Responsibilities

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The Pondicherry Civil Service is a group 'B' administrative service of Pondicherry, India. The PONDICS service officers are responsible for the contribution towards the development of governance of the Union Territory. In this article, we are going to cover the eligibility criteria, roles and responsibilities and career prospects of PONDICS Officers.

Pondicherry Civil Service Eligibility Criteria

To be qualified to become Pondicherry Civil Service office, the following eligibility criteria needs to be met:

Criteria	Details
Age	21 to 32 years (age relaxation applicable for OBC, SC, ST as per government norms)

Qualification	Bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university
Number of Attempts	General: 6 attempts OBC: 9 attempts SC/ST: Unlimited attempts
Nationality	Must be an Indian citizen
Physical Requirement	Must meet the prescribed physical standards

PONDICS Roles and Responsibilities

PONDICS, Group 'B' Officers are responsible for running the administration of Pondicherry Union Territory. Their roles and responsibilities include:

- Implements government policies and schemes and ensures that people receive maximum benefits.
- Pondicherry Civil Servants maintain peace and safety in their assigned areas to prevent any disturbances.
- PONDICS Officers are responsible for enforcing rules and actions and investigate and enforce regulations.
- Collaborate with various government departments to make sure that services reach people effectively.
- Oversee day to day operations, public resources and manage administrative responsibilities to show transparency and responsibility.
- Contribute in policy making and developing effective strategies for Pondicherry's development.
