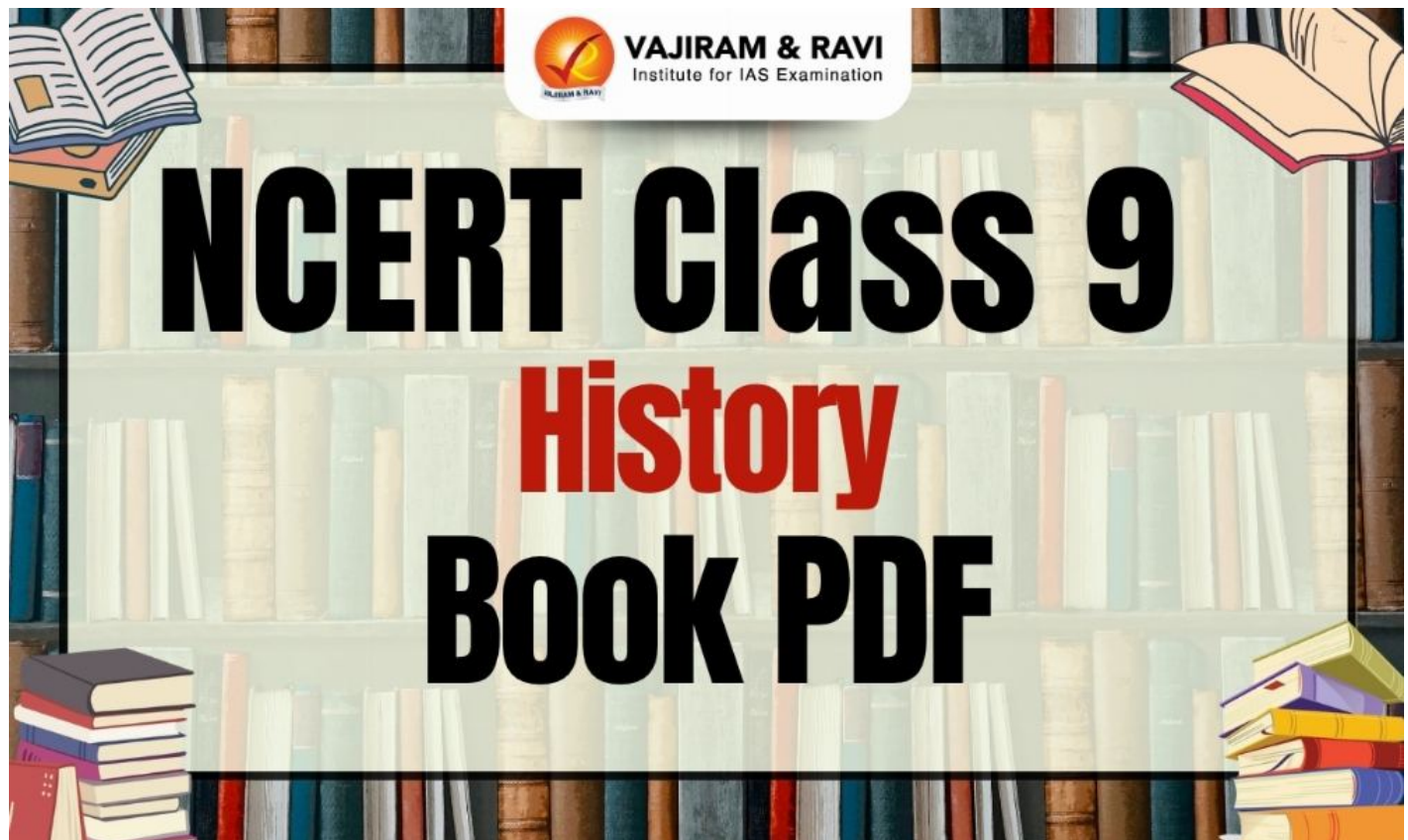


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1. Revolutions like the French and Russian Revolutions are mentioned in the UPSC Syllabus 2025.
