- Important aspects of governance: transparency, accountability, e-governance
- Role of civil services in democracy
- Citizen charters, RTI, public service delivery
- Institutional and regulatory frameworks (NITI Aayog, NHRC, CIC, etc.)

UPSC Governance Syllabus 2025 Prelims

While governance is not directly mentioned in the UPSC Prelims GS Paper I Syllabus 2025, questions often test the aspirant's awareness of current governance-related schemes, rights-based laws, and institutional reforms. These topics are covered under the Polity section of UPSC Prelims Syllabus. Important areas to focus include:

- RTI Act, Lokpal and Lokayuktas
- Important government initiatives (Digital India, Good Governance Index)
- Institutions like CAG, Election Commission, NHRC, etc.
- Social justice schemes and their implementation
- Issues in public service delivery and e-governance

UPSC Governance Syllabus 2025 Mains

Governance is an important component of GS Paper II. The questions are conceptual and opinion-based, often requiring a balanced, analytical response supported by examples. Topics that regularly appear include:

- Role of civil servants in good governance
- Challenges in policy implementation
- E-governance, applications, models, limitations
- Participatory governance and citizen engagement
- RTI Act and its effectiveness
- Issues of transparency and accountability in governance
- Recent governance reforms

UPSC Governance Syllabus 2025 Preparation Strategy

- Understand the UPSC Governance Syllabus 2025 thoroughly, Break it into sub-topics using the GS II structure.
- Focus on editorials, government schemes, reforms, and civil service news.
- Using government sources including PIB, PRS, ARC Reports, and NITI Aayog publications are crucial.
- Make short notes, one-page summaries for RTI, Lokpal, E-governance models, etc.
- Practice answer writing by utilising previous year questions and model questions to write structured answers.
