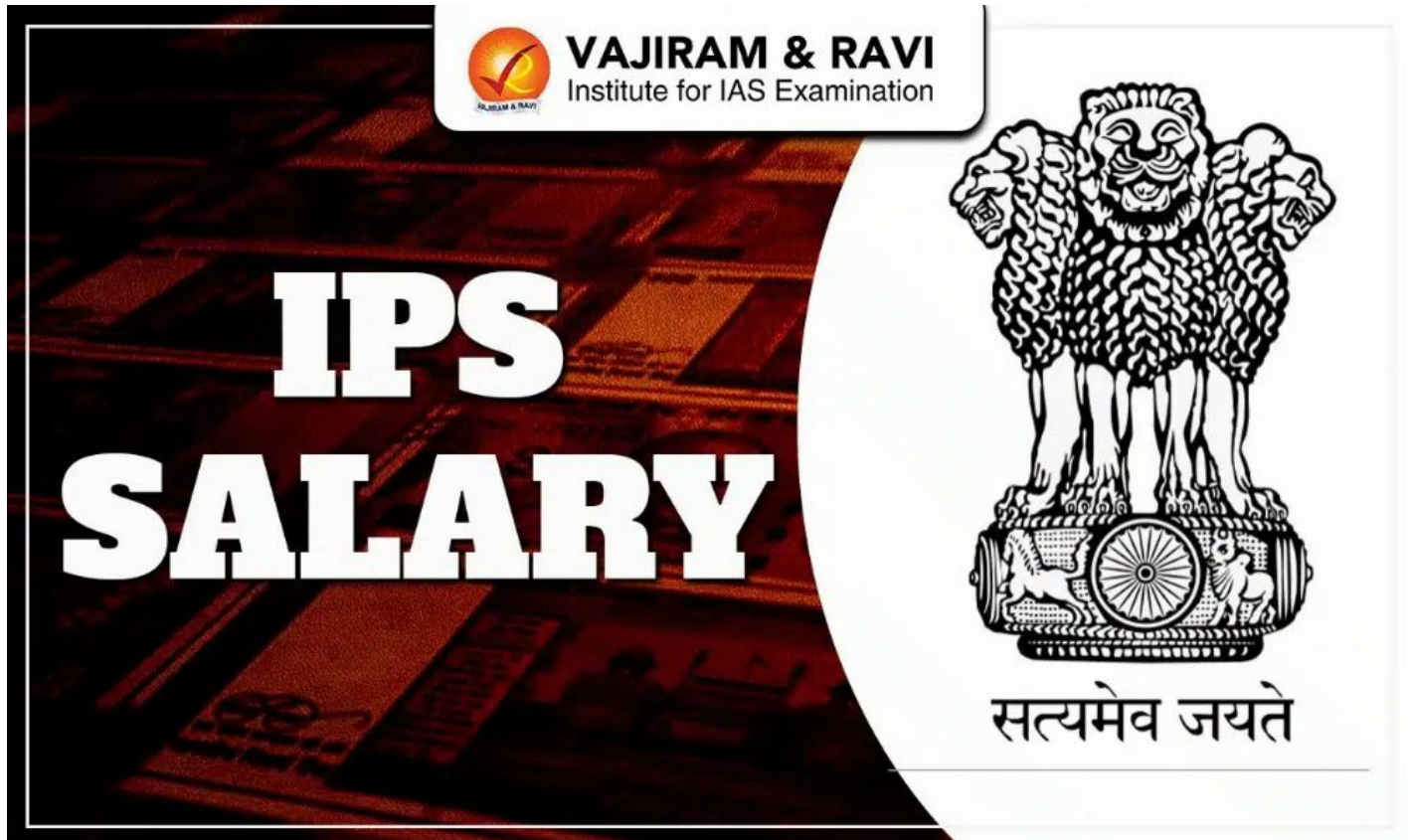


IPS Salary 2026, Grade Pay, Perks and Allowances, Per Month Salary

IPS Salary Per Month

The basic salary of an IPS officer is determined based on the pay scale and the level at which they are appointed. The basic pay for an entry-level IPS officer at the Junior Scale level (Deputy Superintendent of Police or Assistant Commissioner of Police) is around **INR 56,100 per month**. As officers progress to higher ranks and levels, their basic pay increases substantially.

In addition to the basic IPS salary, officers are entitled to receive grade pay, which varies depending on their rank and level. The grade pay is an additional component that contributes to the overall salary of an officer. Furthermore, since January 2016, the Indian government has implemented the 7th Central Pay Commission, which introduced a new Pay Matrix system. The Pay Matrix has various pay levels and corresponding pay bands, each determining the salary of IPS officers based on their rank and years of service.

IPS Officer Salary and Ranks

The IPS officer salary varies based on their rank and level of experience. 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IAS vs IPS Salary

Currently, the **monthly salary of an IPS officer ranges from INR 56,100 to INR 2,25,000**, depending on their seniority. Similarly, for IAS officers, the salary ranges from Rs. 56,100 to Rs. 2,50,000 per month, with their higher pay scale attributed to their roles and responsibilities.
