Managed by the Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, ITS Officers primarily oversee India's foreign trade and commerce.

Indian Trade Service Salary Perks and Allowance

1. **Travel Allowance for Official Duties:** Officers get the reimbursement covering all travel costs and providing a dedicated travel allowance if the travel is a part of their jobs.
2. **Housing Provision:** The government provides accommodation facilities to the officers who are expected to reside with their families in these quarters in any district or state.
3. **Dearness Allowance (DA):** This allowance is a percentage of their basic pay and is periodically revised to counter the impact of inflation.
4. **Household Assistance:** Officers are eligible for a domestic helper and security personnel for household support.
5. **Medical Coverage:** Full healthcare benefits are extended to the officer's family throughout their service.
6. **Additional Utilities:** Government provides financial security and stability to retired officers such as Pension and Retirement Benefits.

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
