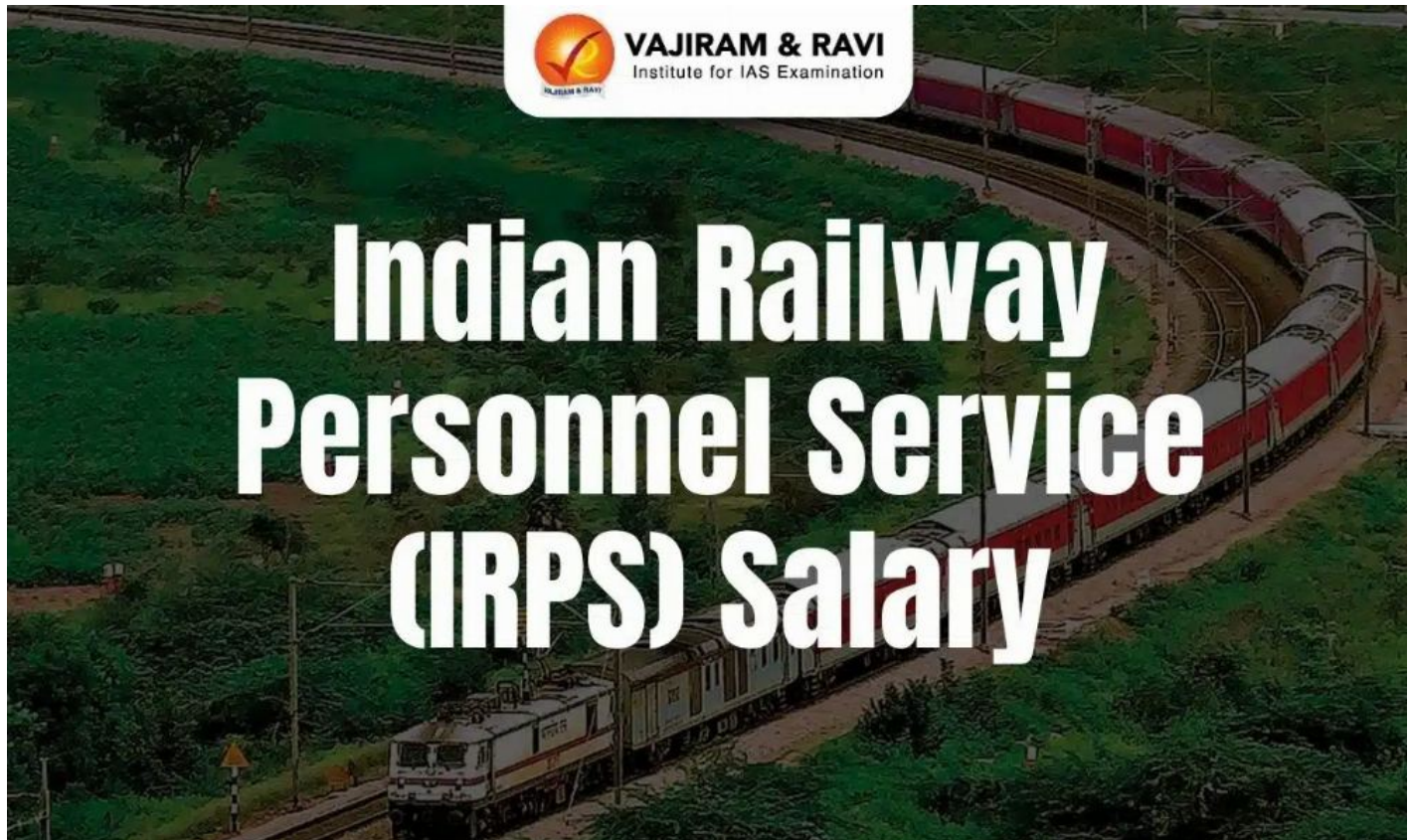


Indian Railway Personnel Service (IRPS) Salary, Job Profile, Allowances

The IRPS Salary 2025 depends on specific job profile, and officers are required to serve a probation period of three years usually. The IRPS Salary 2025 follows the guidelines set by the 7th Pay Commission. IRPS Salary Structure 2025

Indian Railway Personnel Service positions are highly attractive due to their competitive salaries. For grades, salary is the sum of grade pay and pay scale, detailed further in the table below.

Indian Railway Personnel Service Salary Perks and Allowance

Indian Railway Personnel Service Officers also hold various benefits in addition to their salary packages. Each promotion brings an increase in their basic salary, alongside Indian Railway Personnel Service Salary Perks and Allowance:

1. **Travel Allowance for Official Duties:** Officers get the reimbursement covering all travel costs and providing a dedicated travel allowance if the travel is a part of their jobs.
2. **Housing Provision:** The government provides accommodation facilities to the officers who are expected to reside with their families in these quarters in any district or state.
3. **Dearness Allowance (DA):** This allowance is to offset the cost of living, adjusting to inflation and maintaining a steady financial balance.
4. **Household Assistance:** Officers are eligible for a domestic helper and security personnel for household support.
5. **Medical Coverage:** Full healthcare benefits are extended to the officer's family throughout their service.
6. **Additional Utilities:** Government provides financial security and stability to retired officers such as Pension and Retirement Benefits.

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
